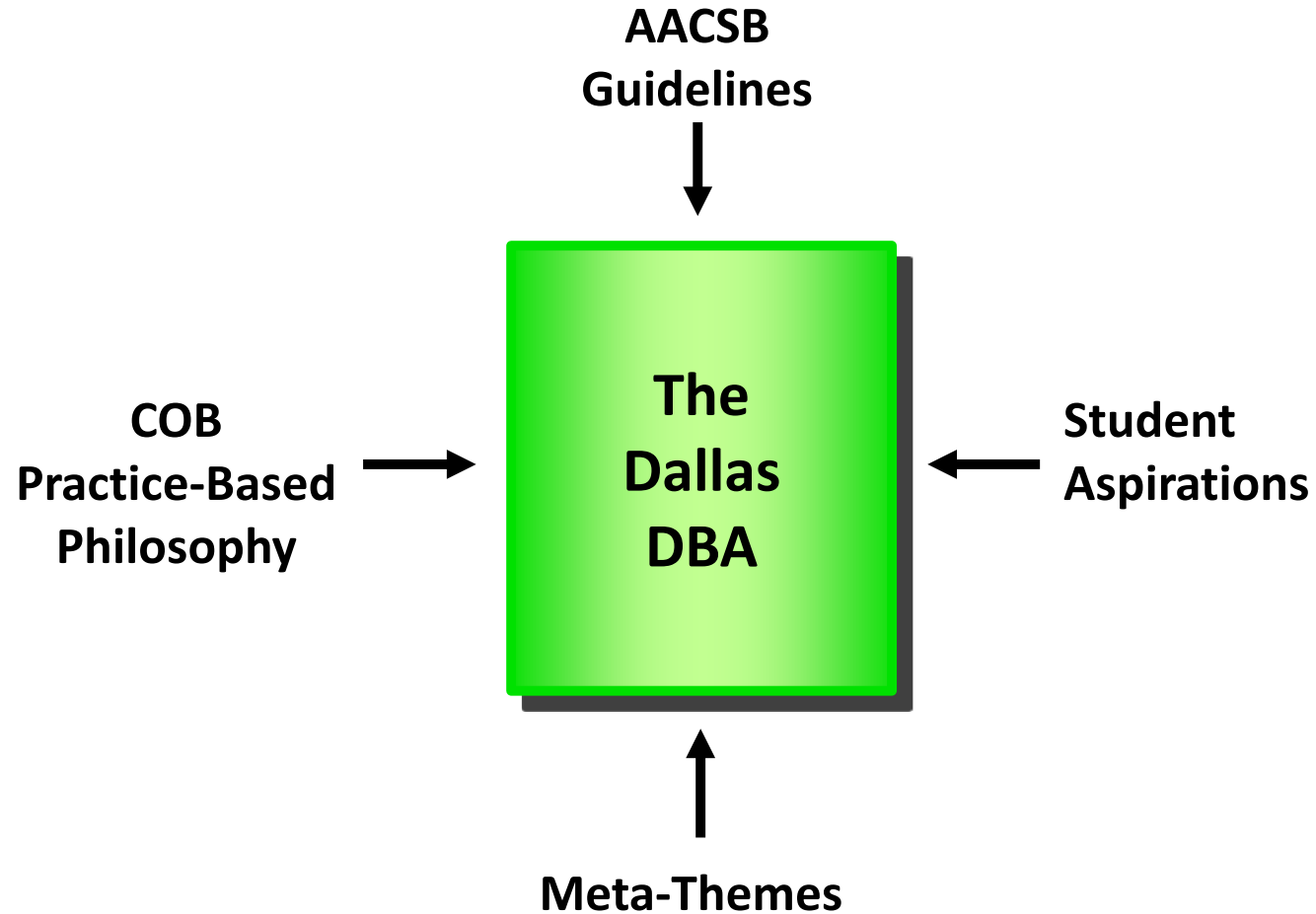

DBA Curriculum: *AACSB Standards*

- **Innovation:** focus on quality of education and supporting functions. Standards are demanding yet realistic thresholds that challenge educators to innovate as well as pursue continuous improvement.
- **Impact:** Focus on outcomes and processes rather than primarily on inputs.
- **Engagement:** Preparation of students for meaningful professional, societal, and personal lives.

DBA Curriculum: AACSB Standards

The **DBA** is a **Professional Doctorate** (as defined in new AACSB Standards):

“In addition to the general skill areas and additional learning experiences for specialized master’s degrees, professional doctoral degrees normally include learning experiences in the following areas:

- Understanding the scholarly literature ***across a range of business and management disciplines***
- ***Understanding of managerial and organizational contexts*** for area of specialization
- Conducting ***rigorous research for application to practice*** in the specified discipline
- ***Preparation for careers applying research to practice*** or
- ***Preparation for teaching responsibilities in higher education*** (for those students who expect to enter teaching careers)
- The professional doctorate is distinguished from the *Research Doctorate*.

Student Aspirations

For those who plan to remain in industry:

- **Equipped to use an evidence-based approach to dealing with adaptive challenges**
- **Ability to identify emerging trends**
- **Understand the implications of those trends for developing innovative strategic organizational responses**

For those who plan to teach:

- **Teaching assignments may be broad**
- **Teaching assignments may be at the undergraduate or graduate levels**
- **May be asked to teach outside of focus area**

The Dallas DBA: Program Format

- **Hybrid Format that blends on-line content with residency weekends**
- **Residency weekends throughout the year**
 - **Once per month Friday/Saturday**
- **Two years of class with two classes per term**
- **One year (last year) of dissertation**
- **Cohort, lock-step curriculum**
